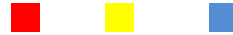
We are Kiwanis.

We are redesigning our Kiwanis Club to make it easier to get involved!

Our club meets at 7 am on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month at the Buchanan Town Hall on County N. Club meetings are a time of fellowship, sharing and presentations by speakers. On the second Thursday of each month, our Board meets at the same time and place to conduct club business; all club members are invited to attend these meetings. In addition to these meetings, we have scheduled service projects and/or social events each month. Attendance at meetings is encouraged, however we recognize that everyone has demanding schedules and may not be able to attend all functions. Membership is about being involved: sharing your time and talents to help make a positive difference. If you have time to serve, our club can make membership convenient for your schedule.

Membership dues are \$100 per year and go to our International organization to sponsor International Kiwanis programs and provide our club with valuable resources. Dues may be paid quarterly and many companies reimburse Kiwanis membership fees.
